To all non-franchise dealers,

Senate Bill 248 amends Section 66-4-2 NMSA 1978 to require continuing education training annually for non-franchised dealerships to renew their license.

"66-4-2. DEPARTMENT TO ISSUE LICENSE.-- A. Except for recreational vehicles, the department, upon receiving an initial nonfranchise dealership application accompanied by the required fee and when satisfied that the applicant has completed eight hours of education as approved by the department and complies with the laws of this state with reference to the registration of vehicles and certificates of title and the provisions of the Motor Vehicle Code, shall issue to the applicant a license that entitles the licensee to conduct the business of a dealer, auto recycler or title service company. The license may be renewed upon application, payment of the fee required by law and **completion every year of four hours of continuing education** as approved by the department. A licensee shall not lease, loan, transfer or sell its license to another person, and no person shall use the license of another person for any purpose.
